- After 30 years since launching the CICA process, the international community recognizes the CICA as a pan-Asian platform for dialogue and cooperation, which is of paramount importance for global security.
- The intensity and nature of threats faced by modern Asia makes this platform relevant, as it promotes peaceful coexistence of all States, regardless of their political systems.
- CICA, which has become the largest organization of this kind, is a unique international project with the potential exceeding the capabilities of many existing regional multilateral structures.
- In 2020, Kazakhstan assumed the chairmanship in CICA with the strategic goal of transforming CICA into a full-fledged Organization which will reflect the Asia's rapidly growing role in global affairs/
- The Kazakh Chairmanship is holding intensive consultations with all 27 CICA Member States to prepare the launch of transformation process at the Sixth CICA Summit to be held in Nur-Sultan in October 2022.
- I also take this opportunity to express our appreciation to all the Member States for being supportive to a number of the initiatives of Kazakh Chairmanship aimed at the advancing and institutionalizing the CICA process, namely establishment of the Council of Eminent Persons, CICA Fund, updating the CICA Catalogue of Confidence Building Measures and holding a number of events with added value to increase the cooperation and connectivity at the CICA platform.

• I hope that the new ideas and economic tools proposed at the meetings of the Business Council and the Business Forum will contribute in improving the well-being of people in the CICA space and in understanding the common destiny of Asian peoples united in pan-Asian organization by common values.

- Today our attention will be focused on the prospects for cooperation in the field of digitalization of business processes in small and medium enterprises and food security within the CICA space. This is very relevant in the context of the current situation, which brought disruptions to the traditional commercial ties of commodity producers despite the considerably growing demand for food production in the CICA space the most densely populated region of the world.
- I hope your discussion today will result in the emergence of new ideas, strengthen existing economic ties between peoples and entrepreneurs, and create of new enterprises and jobs.
- Cooperation in achieving food security leads to a fewer community burdens, less risks of illegal activities and more mutual benefits. Today's discussion will bring new perspectives towards realizing this goal.
- In this regard, we consider the activities of the Business Council and the Business Forum as CICA's contribution to the achievement of the UN Sustainable Development Goals in eradicating poverty, creating new jobs, strengthening partnerships, which directly correlates with the priorities of Kazakhstan's chairmanship in the CICA.
